

# DEFENSIBLE SPACE: GRAVEL GRANT APPLICATION

### WHO WE ARE

Global Emergency Relief, Recovery & Reconstruction (GER<sup>3</sup>) supports crisis-affected communities globally to build back better. GER<sup>3</sup> is working with Altadena residents affected by the Eaton Fire to offer home hardening and fire-resistant defensible space services to build a more wildfire prepared community.

### DEFENSIBLE SPACE:

A top factor in protecting your home against wildfires is creating five feet of defensible space around the perimeter, or "Zone 0". All combustible material must be cleared within this zone and replaced with hardscape (gravel). If approved, GER<sup>3</sup> will provide gravel to home that can show they have cleared Zone 0.

To qualify, homeowners must remove: weeds, bark or mulch, artificial turf, all vegetation, wood or plastic edging, wood fences and gates, moveable items (including potted plants).

### PROGRAM STEPS:

1. Scan the QR code to register for the gravel grant after you have cleared your Zone 0.
2. If approved, GER<sup>3</sup> will provide vouchers for a local gravel supplier.
3. Select type and amount of gravel from supplier.  
\*Value of voucher reflects delivery fee and dollar amount needed to fill the average-sized Zone 0 with grey pea gravel, pictured above
4. Supplier will deliver gravel to your home.  
\*Delivery determined by supplies, some addresses may not be able to receive delivery
5. You spread the gravel around your Zone 0.
