Jason Markel grew up on job sites. He was sweeping floors on Markel Homes building sites at age eight and helping frame houses by twelve, then spent high school summers and weekends as an assistant superintendent and estimator. After earning a Bachelor of Science in Construction Management and Architecture from Cal State Chico, he joined Markel Homes in 2005 as a building superintendent and has spent the last 20 years taking the company's communities from raw-ground entitlements through build-out. Today he is a Principal of Markel Homes.

Founded in Boulder in 1973, Markel Homes has spent more than 50 years designing and building award-winning, multigenerational neighborhoods across Boulder County and the Front Range – including Dakota Ridge Village, the Northfield neighborhoods, North End, Silver Creek, and West Grange. The company is a Department of Energy Zero Energy Ready Home builder and a recipient of the Boulder County Gold Best Builder Award, the U.S. Green Building Council Leadership Award, and the EPA Indoor airPLUS Leader Award.

Jason's current focus is Mountain Village, an 84-acre, 143-home community in Jefferson County that is Colorado's first IBHS Wildfire Prepared Neighborhood. Every home is built to the IBHS standard and more than half the site is preserved as open space. The project was developed in partnership with West Metro Fire Rescue, IBHS, and the Colorado Fire Commission.

Jason serves on the board of the Home Builders Association of Metro Denver. When he's not on a job site he's on a mountain bike or skiing the Colorado backcountry. He and his wife have two kids and live in a Markel Homes community in Boulder.
